play and prove their mettle in various sports and games at school, district and state level competitions. Sports meet always gives a thrilling experience for students. Kickhoff football training is a central government programme for girls under 12years and 7girls are selected from our school.

Co-curricular activities – Karatte, Yoga, Music and dance provide children opportunities to showcase their talents. House wise and open House competitions were conducted throughout the year. School conducts youth festivals for Kindergarten and school section separately every year. Very happy to say that seven girls participated in CBSE state Kalolsav at Vazhakulam in group dance under category II and won A Grade.

A number of competitions were conducted in connection with Reading week, 150 birthday of Gandhiji, Fit India etc. Days of National and International importance like, Independence Day, Teachers'day, Gandhi jayanti, Children's Day, Republic Day, Onam, Christmas are celebrated with great loyalty. These occasions help to promote secularism, unity, harmony and to spread the message of peace and universal brotherhood. To imbibe the value based education in the mind of the students, the institution aspires its pupils develop civic sense. Students bring coconuts and detergents to support New Malabar Rehabilitation centre and also collected money for flood relief work.

Scouts and Guides: The vision of Mother Alexia focuses on holistic development of a pupil. The purpose of Scout & Guide, Cubs & bulbul are the Movements to contribute the development of young people in achieving their full physical, intellectual, social and spiritual as individuals, as responsible citizens and as members of the local, national and international communities.
